

MOVING MOUNTAINS: CAMP BENEDICT CELEBRATES 25 YEARS

Few resources were available to people with HIV/ AIDS when Connie Statz was diagnosed after a blood transfusion in the early '90s. Knowing other people faced similar struggles, Connie envisioned a place where families affected by the disease could find relief and support.

In 1994, her vision manifested at Camp Knutson through our partner Camp Benedict. This weeklong camp, founded by Connie and Renee Steffen, offered campers and their loved ones a supportive environment where they could share their experiences, learn and recharge. Connie passed away in 2015, but the camp she founded celebrated its 25th year this summer.

In its early years, Camp focused on medical hurdles, dealing with stigma and making end-of-life plans.

As medicine advanced and awareness spread, Camp shifted its focus to quality of life – a prospect that often felt out of reach to campers decades ago. Today, Camp emphasizes mental wellness, healthy relationships, self-care and personal growth.

"We can deal with things in our life now that we couldn't deal with before because we were trying

so hard to survive," said Camp Benedict President Rob Andrews, who is a former camper himself. "Taking care of yourself is, in a way, moving mountains."

Each member of the family leaves with coping skills to use in their daily lives, new friendships and a community that understands and supports them.

"Campers are all going through the same things. It doesn't matter where you come from or what color you are," said Sheila DeChantal, Camp Benedict vice president. "There's always so much love, openness and acceptance. It's amazing to see how much they support each other."

'CAMP WAS FREEDOM': COMING FULL CIRCLE

Tassy was just 12 when her mother was diagnosed with AIDS in 1995. She saw firsthand how the condition, combined with lung cancer, drained her mother's energy and eroded her health. Tassy felt alone. Serious illness seemed to be foreign to other kids her age. The stigma surrounding AIDS deterred her from telling even her closest friends.

"I didn't think anybody else was dealing with the issues we had," Tassy said. "I really had nobody who understood it besides my family."

That year, Tassy's family came to Camp Knutson. They attended a weeklong camp through our partner Camp Benedict, dedicated to individuals and families affected by HIV and AIDS. At Camp, Tassy finally met other kids who shared similar experiences.

"We knew that everyone there was affected by this disease one way or another, so you didn't have to worry that you would be outcast," Tassy said. "Most of us dealt with that year-round, but Camp was freedom. It was a total release for that week."

Tassy and her siblings attended Camp for three years, until their mother passed away. She and her sister returned with their own families for Camp Benedict's 20th anniversary in 2014.

Returning after more than a decade, the sisters built friendships with other campers, many of whom they keep contact with year-round. Coming back to Camp, Tassy said, was especially powerful for her sister in gaining closure over their mother's death.

"We talked a lot about our family coming for the first few years of Camp Benedict," Tassy said. "Coming back with our kids was really full-circle."

Music therapist Todd Schwartzberg has seen how music therapy empowers individuals to strengthen communications skills, calm themselves in stressful situations and engage in complex learning environments. Since 2002, Todd has brought his expertise to Camp Knutson through our partner Camp Hand in Hand, which provides summer camp to youth and adults with autism.

Todd creates musical opportunities for campers to engage at whatever level they are comfortable. Those opportunities could include campers using words and images to write songs, trying their hand at musical instruments or simply listening to music.

Todd explained that these music sessions are different than music therapy and that he designs them to have therapeutic elements. These sessions





offer campers fun opportunities to initiate social interactions, express themselves creatively and discover new possibilities for themselves.

"Whether campers are strumming the guitar or getting to use the big drum set, there are many opportunities that show us we're setting up campers for success," Todd said.

Many campers are often reserved when they first join in the music activities. Once they start picking a guitar or recognize the lyrics to a song, they open up and engage with one another.

"I've strived to create an environment where campers know they are accepted for the incredible individuals they are," Todd said.
