# Value-Based Models in Home & Community-Based Services

Value-Based Models in home and community-based services for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities promote effective approaches to housing, employment and healthcare integration. Moving toward these alternative payment models has great potential to help Minnesota improve the health and quality of life of people with intellectual and developmental disabilities while lowering costs.

Minnesota has the opportunity to lead other states into the future of these services in a unique Minnesota way by committing to:

- Careful planning and policy vision to advance community-integrated, quality home and community-based services with quality, disability-competent healthcare services.
- Collection of clear outcomes data.
- Incremental approaches that minimize disruption to lives.
- Significant and ongoing engagement with stakeholders.
- A focus on trusting relationships.
- Person-centered quality measures like those of the Council on Quality and Leadership.

## 2019 Proposal:

Directs the Minnesota Department of Human Services, in partnership with stakeholders, to study and recommend value-based models and outcome-based payment strategies in home and community-based services to improve the quality, efficiency, and effectiveness of services by October 1, 2020.


